LOOKING TO ALTERNATIVES

The Commonwealth Government will provide \$4 million to the University of Western Sydney to help establish a National Institute for Complementary Medicine, to develop national priorities for complementary medical research.

The group will coordinate work on these priorities alongside other research bodies, with an emphasis on clinical trials and studies on herbal medicines.

The institute will also support postdoctoral training to ensure that the industry has the research personnel it needs to expand, as well as provide research findings to the medical community and general public.
